

ASTROSKATE KWINANA (EXCURSION)



LEGO KIT



I understand that all fees are to be paid (in full) a minimum of 1 week in advance in accordance with the fee estimate given to me by the accounts department in relation to the sessions I have booked for my child/children. I understand that failure to do so may result in my child/children being refused care until my account is paid in accordance with this policy (fees will still be charged for book sessions even if the child is refused care due to failure to adhere to the fee payment policy). Happy Hive Oshc & Vacation Care Centre reserves the right to refer client accounts to the Magistrates Court of Western Australia for collection of overdue monies and all fees associated with collection of overdue monies will be added to my account (including any interest deemed applicable by the Magistrate).

Discipline Policy
